A high potential for securing external research funding will be a plus. Ability to collaborate with faculty both within and outside the department is also desirable but not required.

The department has an active group of statisticians whose research interests include biostatistics, dimension reduction, nonlinear and nonparametric regression, saddlepoint approximations, survival analysis, and time series analysis.
