The Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science invites applications for one or more non-tenure-track 2/3-time faculty positions on a one-year appointment to teach statistics during the 2011-2012 academic year. Applicants should possess a Ph.D. in Statistics or a related area by August 17, 2011. This position requires excellent communication skills and experience in teaching elementary biostatistics is desired. Fall appointments begin August 17, 2011, and candidates must be legally able to work in the United States on that date.

Application should include a letter of interest, a current CV, graduate transcripts, and three letters of recommendation.
