The Division of Biostatistics in the Department of Biostatistics and Epidemiology at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine seeks a highly qualified candidate for a tenure track standing faculty position at the Associate level. A doctoral degree in Biostatistics, Statistics, or a related discipline is required. Review of applications will begin on May 1, 2011. Application will continue to be accepted after this date, until the positions are filled. The expected start date is October 2011 or later.

Tenure track applicants should be primarily focused on methodological research, with substantial involvement in collaborative research projects within the School of Medicine. There is a rich mix of ongoing biomedical research projects in the School of Medicine to provide motivation and opportunities for the development of novel statistical methods on wide ranging topics. Applicants with research interests in health services research, causal modeling and comparative effectiveness research are especially encouraged to apply. Candidates are expected to have a strong commitment to teaching and must demonstrate outstanding research productivity or the potential to do so. Responsibilities also include participation in Penn's Center for Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics teaching programs.

The Graduate Group in Epidemiology and Biostatistics, jointly with the Dept of Statistics in the Wharton School, offers degree programs leading to both the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) and Master of Science (MS) in Biostatistics.
