**Announcement of Position In  
Statistics to Begin Fall 2011**

**DESCRIPTION:** This is a tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level. Position duties include teaching, research, and service to the university and department to include advising mathematics majors. The full-time teaching load is normally three courses per semester (9 credits) for those with an active research program.

**GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidates must present evidence of:

- a Ph.D. in Statistics or a Ph.D. in Mathematics with a thesis topic in Statistics (degrees expected or earned by August 2011);
- at least two years of experience teaching undergraduate statistics and/or mathematics (may include graduate TA experience);
- a commitment to teaching, curriculum development, and assessment;
- ability to apply technology in the classroom;
- interest in teaching general education statistics courses;
- an articulated ongoing program of professional development, including research.

**DEPARTMENT:** The Mathematics Department is the largest department in the Mathematics/Science Division of the College of Letters and Science. It offers a major with emphases in liberal arts, applied mathematics, statistics, and secondary education; minors in each emphasis area; and a separate minor for elementary education majors. It also offers a Master of Science degree in Mathematics Education.
