Applications are invited for a tenure-track Assistant Professorship in Statistics in the department of Mathematical Sciences. Applicants with expertise in any areas of Statistics, particularly Bayesian methods or Nonparametrics, are encouraged to apply. Preference will be given to candidates whose statistics research interests have biomedical and/or social sciences applications. The department has a graduate program offering both an MS in statistics and PhD degree with a concentration in statistics. The Department of Mathematical Sciences is dedicated to excellence in both research and teaching. Candidates should have strong research potential as well as the potential to make a significant contribution to the department's undergraduate educational mission. The standard teaching load is two courses per quarter. Completed applications consisting of a cover letter, CV, description of research program, description of teaching experience, and three letters of recommendation should be submitted on mathjobs.org. Review of applicants will begin on December 15, 2010. Appointments will begin September 1, 2011. The position requires a PhD in-hand in the area of statistics or equivalent by September 1st, 2011.
