



Statistics, Teaching Post-Doc

St. Lawrence University invites applications for a two year post-doc position with a focus on teaching statistics with the Department of Mathematics, Computer Science, and Statistics to begin in August 2016. Qualifications include a Ph.D. (completed or near completion) in statistics, mathematics, or a closely related field including a background in graduate level statistics and strong interest in teaching statistics to undergraduates in a liberal arts setting. This position has a reduced teaching load with opportunities for mentoring from a nationally recognized group of statistics educators.

To apply:

All offers of employment are contingent upon the finalist successfully passing a background (including criminal records) check.
