

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Auburn University, Alabama, is seeking to fill a nine-month tenure-track Assistant Professor position in the area of Data Sciences to begin August 16, 2019. Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Statistics, Data Sciences or a closely related field at the time employment begins. The research emphasis should be on statistical learning, statistical modeling for big data analytics, and/or high performance analytics. Postdoctoral research experience with an interdisciplinary research component and strong computational skills are desirable. The successful candidate will be expected to: (1) develop her/his independent research program in Data Science, (2) interact with and contribute to interdisciplinary research at Auburn University, (3) advise and mentor students, and (4) have a strong commitment to high quality teaching.

The department has a PhD program and various MS programs. It has around 50 mathematicians/statisticians and more than 120 graduate students engaged in research in a wide variety of areas in Mathematics and Statistics. Auburn University's strong research programs in various academic areas present many opportunities for interdisciplinary research and for participation in its various multidisciplinary programs. The department is especially interested in candidates who can contribute to the excellence of the academic community, teaching, and research.
