### **Position Description**

The Department of Statistics at the University of Missouri invites applications for a non-tenure track (NTT) Assistant Teaching Professor. The primary responsibilities of the position are teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in statistics and providing service appropriate to rank. We seek a dedicated teacher and welcome applicants who specialize in any subarea of statistics or biostatistics. An earned doctoral degree in statistics, biostatistics, or a related field is required prior to employment. The successful candidate must be legally able to work in the United States by August 15, 2022.

The University of Missouri values and respects the contributions of NTT faculty. NTT appointments are reviewed regularly, may be renewed indefinitely, and are eligible for promotion following departmental and university guidelines. Contract lengths vary depending on length of service and rank. NTT faculty may participate in departmental, college, and university governance.

The Department of Statistics is committed to the ideal of a diversity faculty and we strongly encourage applications from members of groups underrepresented in our field. We also encourage applications from candidates who demonstrate a commitment to increasing diversity and improving access to higher education for underrepresented groups.
