

The Department of Statistics at the University of Pittsburgh invites applications for a Visiting Lecturer position from August 2021 to April 2024, pending budgetary approval. The position is outside the tenure stream. Minimum qualifications are that candidates should have earned their PhD in Statistics or a closely related discipline by August 2021, have demonstrated excellence in teaching undergraduate courses, and have an interest in innovative instruction. The normal teaching load is three courses each semester. Reductions in teaching may be possible depending on approved non-instructional activities supported by a lecturer.
