



GENERAL SUMMARY:

The Econometrics and Statistics group at the Booth School of Business of the University of Chicago invites applications for a postdoctoral researcher working under the supervision of Prof. Bryon Aragam. Potential candidates should have a background in statistics and machine learning, for example nonconvex optimization, nonparametric statistics, and/or learning theory. Applications of interest include personalization and graphical models, but may also depend on the candidate's individual research interests. There will be an emphasis on theoretical/mathematical problems as well as computational/applied work, with a particular focus on problems at the intersection. The candidate should have a recent Ph.D. degree (or all-but-dissertation) in statistics, computer science, mathematics, or a related area, and should be proficient in programming in Python or R.

This position will continue for one year, with the possibility of renewal for up to three years.
